

GIGABIT BROADBAND VOUCHER SCHEME

SUPPLIER TERMS AND CONDITIONS – UPDATES

DATE: 29 JULY 2020

With effect from 29 July 2020 and as referenced in Supplier Bulletin #38, Schedules 8 and 1 of the Supplier Terms and Conditions are updated in order to provide for additional top-up projects as provided below.

Schedule 8 – Additional Funding

The table in Schedule 8 of the Supplier Terms and Conditions is replaced with the following updated table:

SME Beneficiaries of RGC Projects in Wales is £500 to £7,000 (exclusive of VAT), provided that the £7,000 maximum voucher value applies only if at the time the voucher is requested (as described in clause 9.1.1 above) the available broadband speed at the property is less than 30 Mbps (as determined by the Authority and whether or not the relevant connection is currently in use). Otherwise, the voucher value will be £500 to £3,500 (inclusive of VAT);2. Otherwise, the voucher value will be £500 to £1,500 (exclusive of VAT),</p> <p>in each case whilst voucher funding remains available.</p>

7.	RGC Projects in Dorset (From 29 July 2020 – Updated in Bulletin #38)	The voucher value for: 1. SME Beneficiaries of RGC Projects in Dorset is £500 to £6,000 (exclusive of VAT); and 2. Residential Beneficiaries of RGC Projects in Dorset is £500 to £2,500 (inclusive of VAT), in each case whilst voucher funding remains available.
