West Sussex top up is now closed for new projects

As of 30th November 2021, the West Sussex top-up is no longer available for projects which have not yet been submitted. This is due to the current pipeline of published projects being likely to exhaust the remaining top-up funding.

Projects that have already been submitted and have a status of draft, with supplier or final review, can continue to progress and claim vouchers with the top-up until the West Sussex top-up budget has been exhausted. We will also confirm once the budget has run out.

Whilst the West Sussex 'top up' element will close to any projects submitted from today, they can still continue to progress under the normal terms of the UK Gigabit Voucher. The Digital Infrastructure Team at West Sussex County Council remains keen to work with suppliers and communities to progress projects where they remain viable and welcomes future proposals from suppliers.
